GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADEARTICLE XXVIII:5 NEGOTIATIONSSCHEDULE XVIII - SOUTH AFRICA

The following communication, dated 25 March 1982, has been received from the Permanent Mission of South Africa.

The Government of South Africa has notified the CONTRACTING PARTIES that it reserves the right, in accordance with the provisions of Article XXVIII:5 of the General Agreement, to modify Schedule XVIII - South Africa during the three-year period commencing on 1 January 1982 (TAR/37).

In pursuance of this notification, the Government of South Africa has decided to withdraw the following concessions in Parts I and II of Schedule XVIII - South Africa:
