**SISTEMA ARMONIZADO - NEGOCIACIONES  
EN EL MARCO DEL ARTÍCULO XXVIII**

**PRESENTACIÓN DE DOCUMENTOS**

*Lista LXX - Bangladesh*

La siguiente comunicación, de fecha 29 de noviembre de 2016, se distribuye a petición de la delegación de Bangladesh.

Con miras a concluir las negociaciones en el marco del artículo XXVIII iniciadas originalmente sobre la base de la Decisión del Consejo del GATT, de 12 de julio de 1983<sup>1</sup>, para la transposición a la Nomenclatura del Sistema Armonizado de las Listas de concesiones previas a la Ronda Uruguay<sup>2</sup>, Bangladesh presenta para su distribución los siguientes documentos<sup>3</sup>:

- i) cartas conjuntas e informes de conformidad con lo dispuesto en el párrafo 5 del Procedimiento para las negociaciones en virtud del artículo XXVIII<sup>4</sup>, que fueron suscritos por Bangladesh una vez concluidas sus negociaciones bilaterales con Australia (anexo 1), el Canadá (anexo 2), las Comunidades Europeas (anexo 3) y Nueva Zelanda (anexo 4); y
- ii) un informe final de conformidad con lo dispuesto en el párrafo 6 del Procedimiento para las negociaciones en virtud del artículo XXVIII.

Tal como se exige en el párrafo 8 del Procedimiento para las negociaciones en virtud del artículo XXVIII, Bangladesh presentará un proyecto para incorporar a su Lista de concesiones los cambios derivados de las negociaciones bilaterales mencionadas *supra*, teniendo en cuenta sus obligaciones dimanantes de la Ronda Uruguay. Para tal fin, remitirá en breve la Lista LXX completa de Bangladesh en la Nomenclatura del SA '96, conforme a lo dispuesto en el párrafo 1 de los Procedimientos de 1980 para la modificación o rectificación de las Listas.<sup>5</sup>

**BILATERAL AGREEMENT WITH THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES**

Negotiations under GATT Article XXVIII regarding Schedule LXX – Bangladesh between Bangladesh delegation and Commission of European Communities (EC) delegation took place on 12.09.1995.

Negotiations on request list presented by Finland has been concluded and it was resolved that the custom duty rates shown against item mentioned below shall be bound by Bangladesh and will be shown in relevant Bangladesh notifications/documents/publications as GATT bound rates.

The EC delegation produced a letter dated 5.02.1991 written to the Ambassador, Permanent Mission of Bangladesh, Geneva wherein they expressed reservation on withdrawal of GATT concession on a number of items on which their member countries expressed interest. The Bangladesh delegation wanted to discuss specific proposals and the CEC delegation did so. After a detail negotiation the following customs duty rates on the items below were agreed to be bound subject to the consent of the concerned member countries of the CEC and approval by the Bangladesh authority/Government.
