ARTICLE XXVIII:5 NEGOTIATIONS

Schedule CXXXIX – Bulgaria

The following communication, dated 16 November 2001, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Bulgaria.

In accordance with the provisions and procedures of Article XXVIII, Paragraph 5 of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, the Republic of Bulgaria hereby provides notification that it intends to modify certain concessions on items included in Schedule CXXXIX annexed to the General Agreement.

The Republic of Bulgaria is prepared to enter into negotiations and consultations with the appropriate Members under Article XXVIII for modification of concessions with respect to yeast.
