RECTIFICATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS OF SCHEDULES

Schedule XXI - Indonesia

The following communication, dated 1 April 1997, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Indonesia.

Indonesia is one of the member countries which have agreed to eliminate and bind their customs duties and other charges on information technology products in order to implement the Ministerial Declaration on Trade in Information Technology Products.

In this regard, I would be very grateful if you could reproduce and distribute to WTO member countries our modification of Indonesia's Schedule XXI, in accordance with the Decision of 26 March 1980 on Procedures for Modification and Rectification of Schedules of Tariff Concessions, incorporating our commitment under the Information Technology Agreement (ITA) which was verified at the informal ITA meeting on 26 March 1997.

If no objection is notified to the Secretariat within three months from the date of this document, the rectifications and modifications to Schedule XXI - Indonesia will be deemed to be approved and will be formally certified.
