Schedule LXXV – Philippines

Addendum

The following communication, dated 7 March 2000, has been received from the Permanent Mission of the Philippines.

With reference to the Philippines' notification, G/SECRET/9, indicating our intention to modify certain concessions under Article XXVIII of GATT 1994, we would like to submit the following:

1. Statistics¹ on the volume and value of raw and refined sugar imported by the Philippines, by country of origin, for the years 1997, 1998 and 1999; and
2. Revised Annex¹ of G/SECRET/9, on the list of tariff items subject to modification².
