WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Decision, a draft containing modifications and rectifications to Schedule **CXXXVI - Guinea** was communicated to all Members of the World Trade Organization in document G/MA/TAR/RS/179 dated 15 June 2010;
