SCHEDULE I - COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA

The following communication, dated 27 January 1982, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Australia.

- (i) The Government of Australia has notified the contracting parties that it reserves the right for the duration of the three-year period which began 1 January 1982 to modify its schedule in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5 of Article XXVIII (TAR/41).
- (ii) Pursuant to that notification, the following concession will be modified:

- (iii) The concession was negotiated in the Tokyo Round of tariff negotiations and recorded in document TAR/22 of 18 September 1981.
- (iv) The foregoing concession is to be modified by the additional exclusion of pigmeats packed in airtight containers.
- (v) Detailed import statistics of all pigmeats affected by this modification are attached.
- (vi) Australia will be negotiating compensatory adjustments with the EEC on behalf of Denmark which is the principal most-favoured-nation supplier of the product concerned (in accordance with document L/4906 of 3 December 1979).
