#### Final Report

The following communication, dated 18 February 1993, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Australia.

The Permanent Mission of Australia presents its compliments to the GATT Secretariat and has the honour to refer to document SECRET/337 of 8 September 1992, by which Australia notified its intention, in accordance with Article XXVIII:5 of the General Agreement, to modify a number of concessions. In the notification Australia indicated its readiness to enter into negotiations or consultations under Article XXVIII and requested any contracting party having an interest in the concessions to make this known as soon as possible and in any event within a period of ninety days.

Since no claim of interest has been made within ninety days following the circulation of the above-mentioned notification Australia has decided to modify the concessions, the details of which are set out in the Attachment.
