SCHEDULE XIII - NEW ZEALAND

The following communication dated 10 June 1981 has been received from the Permanent Mission of New Zealand.

The Government of New Zealand has notified the CONTRACTING PARTIES that it reserves the right, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5 of Article XXVIII of the General Agreement, to modify Schedule XIII - New Zealand during the three-year period commencing 1 January 1979 (document L/4743).

In pursuance of this notification, the Government of New Zealand has decided to modify in Part I of Schedule XIII - New Zealand, the following concession:
