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COMUNICACION DE MACAO

Se ha recibido del Gobierno de Macao la siguiente comunicación, de fecha 9 de mayo de 1992.

El Gobierno de Macao saluda atentamente al Director General del GATT y tiene el honor de remitirse a la comunicación hecha el 4 de diciembre de 1991 por el Territorio en el cuadragésimo séptimo período de sesiones de las PARTES CONTRATANTES en el sentido de que, por razones técnicas y logísticas, no estaría en condiciones de completar la lista de consolidación de sus derechos de aduana antes de la fecha límite del 11 de enero de 1992; asimismo, hace referencia a la promesa que formuló en esa misma ocasión de completar toda la labor requerida antes de julio de 1992.

Con arreglo a lo expuesto, el Gobierno de Macao tiene el honor de presentar adjunta su lista de concesiones -que también deberá considerarse en el marco de las negociaciones de la Ronda Uruguay- con el ruego de que la Secretaría del GATT la distribuya a las demás partes contratantes a efectos de certificación.

Si en el plazo de 90 días a partir de la fecha del presente documento no se notifica a la Secretaría ninguna objeción, la Lista LXXXIX - Macao se considerará aprobada y será oficialmente certificada.
