CHANGES IN THE HARMONIZED SYSTEM

Submission of Documentation

Schedule LXXX - European Communities

The following communication, dated 20 February 1992, has been received from the Commission of the European Communities.

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With reference to GATT document L/6905, please find enclosed the following documentation related to the proposed changes in our GATT Schedule:

- (1) some general observations on the changes,
- (2) a concordance table showing the impact on the existing and proposed schedule of the substantive changes mentioned in TAR/W/83/Rev.1,
- (3) replacement pages (English and French versions) of the EC's proposed Loose Leaf Schedule with all changes underlined.

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If no objection is notified to the Secretariat within ninety days from the date of this document, the changes to Schedule LXXX - European Communities will be deemed to be approved and will be formally certified.

HS changes to EC GATT Schedule LXXX

General observations

- (1) These modifications made to the Schedule LXXX - EC following the amendments made by the CCC to the nomenclature of the Harmonized System do not result in disadvantages for the CONTRACTING PARTIES, except in one case. In all other cases they are of a purely formal character or even favourable for the CONTRACTING PARTIES by reductions of bound rates.
- (2) In the case of the re-classification of "resin acids" from subheading 3806 90 to sub-heading 3806 10 the bound rate will increase from 4.6% to 5%. The CCC had adopted the regrouping of rosins and resin acids with unanimity "because of the close resemblance which exists in their composition and their utilization and of the lack of criteria allowing a consistent distinction between rosin and resin acids". Because of this and in view of the minimal increase in the bound rate, the EEC considers this modification equally as a modification of a purely formal character.
- (3) It should be noted that no formal modifications are necessary in Schedule LXXX regarding whey protein concentrates and containers similar to the goods specified in the second part of heading 4202 wholly or mainly covered with paper. In both cases these products have already been classified by the EC since its adoption of the Harmonized System on 1 January 1988 within the respective HS headings designated by the modifications to the HS nomenclature items 3502.90.00 and 4202.39.00 and 4202.99.00.

1 Within the limit of an annual quota of 3500 tonnes to be granted by the competent Community authorities, a rate of 15 ECU per 100 Kg net weight is provided for cheese for processing and imported from a third country in the framework of a special arrangement concluded between that country and the Community subject to the production of an IMA 1 certificate, delivered in accordance with the conditions laid down in the relevant Community provisions. Furthermore, entry under this quota and verification of the end-use shall be subject to conditions laid down in the relevant Community provisions.

2 For cheeses, imported from a third country in the framework of a special arrangement concluded between that country and the Community, and for which an IMA 1 certificate is presented, delivered in accordance with the conditions laid down in the relevant Community provisions.

4 Within the limit of an annual quota of 9000 tonnes to be granted by the competent Community authorities, a rate of 15 ECU per 100 Kg net weight is provided for whole Cheddar cheeses of a minimum fat content of 50 % by weight in the dry matter, matured for at least three months and imported from a third country in the framework of a special arrangement concluded between that country and the Community subject to the production of an IMA 1 certificate delivered in accordance with the conditions laid down in the relevant Community provisions.

For these purposes "whole cheeses" means:

-cheeses of the conventional flat cylindrical shape of a net weight of not less than 33 Kg but not more than 44 Kg.

-cheeses of the conventional flat cylindrical shape or cheeses in parallelepiped shape, of a net weight of 10 Kg or more.

-Furthermore, entry under this quota shall be subject to conditions to be determined by the competent Community authorities.
