ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW SCHEDULE XXI - INDONESIA

Addendum

The following communication, dated 4 January 1983, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Indonesia.

I have the honour to transmit herewith copies of the bilateral agreements¹ recently concluded between the Government of Indonesia and the Governments of Finland and Canada respectively on the establishment of the new Schedule XXI - Indonesia under Article XXVIII.

As you are aware similar agreements have also been concluded between the Government of Indonesia and the Governments of Australia, the EEC, Japan and the United States.

With reference to the outstanding bilateral discussions between the Governments of Indonesia and New Zealand, it was agreed between the parties to resume them in 1983, with the understanding that no further waiver would be requested for this purpose. Copies of the exchange of notes are enclosed.¹

Addendum

La Mission permanente de l'Indonésie a fait parvenir au secrétariat la communication ci-après en date du 4 janvier 1983.

J'ai l'honneur de vous transmettre, ci-joint, copie des accords bilatéraux¹ que le gouvernement de l'Indonésie a récemment conclus avec les gouvernements de la Finlande et du Canada au sujet de l'établissement d'une nouvelle Liste XXI – Indonésie, conformément aux dispositions de l'article XXVIII.

Comme vous le savez, des accords semblables ont aussi été conclus entre le gouvernement de l'Indonésie et les gouvernements de l'Australie, de la CEE, des Etats-Unis d'Amérique et du Japon.

En ce qui concerne les pourparlers bilatéraux en suspens entre les gouvernements de l'Indonésie et de la Nouvelle-Zélande, les parties sont convenues de les reprendre en 1983, étant entendu qu'aucune nouvelle dérogation ne sera demandée à cet effet. Une copie des notes échangées est jointe à la présente lettre.¹

Excellency,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated December 24, 1982 which reads as follows :

"With reference to the recent series of bilateral negotiations held in both Geneva and Jakarta, regarding the renegotiations of Schedule XXI - Indonesia, I wish to remind you that these negotiations, in-so-far as they relate to discussions between our two countries, have yet to be concluded.

Bearing in mind the fact that the waiver from the obligations of article II of general agreement which Indonesia currently enjoys expires on 31 December 1982, and that there is now no possibility of reaching finality on the matters still under consideration by our authorities, it is necessary to reach agreement on the manner in which both parties should henceforth proceed.

Acting on advice received from the GATT Secretariat, my Government agrees not to request a further extension of your present waiver, but instead proposes this formal exchange of letters. These will constitute an agreement to continue negotiations in 1983 without extending the waiver until a solution satisfactory to both parties is reached. I therefore set out below my understanding of the position reached to date :

(a). The Government of Indonesia has agreed to bind the following items to New Zealand in GATT Schedule XXI, at the rates of duty shown :

- (b). The Government of Indonesia has agreed to grant initial negotiating rights (UNR'S) to New Zealand on those items above which are preceded by and asterisk.
- (c). The Government of Indonesia has not agreed to bind item 04.02.211 "non fat skimmed milk powder in packing of 25 Kg net or more" at the rate requested by New Zealand (i.e. 30 per cent). In this regard the New Zealand Government earnestly enjoins the Indonesian Government to give further consideration to this matter.
- (d). The Government of New Zealand and the Government of Indonesia agree to resume consultations in the course of 1983, with a view to concluding negotiations in regard to the establishment of a new Schedule XXI - Indonesia.

As requested by your Government this exchange is taking place in Jakarta, we will forwarded a copy of this note to the GATT Secretariat. I understand that you will be writing to me confirming and giving effect to this understanding". I hereby confirm that the above mentioned understanding constitutes an agreement between the New Zealand and the Indonesian sides.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
