The Government of South Africa has notified the CONTRACTING PARTIES that it reserves the right, in accordance with the provisions of Arti-cle XXVIII:5 of the General Agreement, to modify Schedule XVIII- South Africa during the three-year period commencing on 1 January 1982 (TAR/37).

In pursuance of this notification, the Government of South Africa has decided to withdraw the following concession in Part II of Schedule XVIII-South Africa:
