The following communication, dated 30 August 1984, has been received from the Permanent Mission of South Africa.

I have the honour to refer to my letter of 31 January 1984 and to document SECRET/306 of 7 February 1984 and to request you to replace the notification for the withdrawal of a concession falling within item 73.15 by a notification for the modification of a concession falling within item 73.15 in Schedule XVIII - South Africa, as follows:
