WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Decision, a draft containing modifications and rectifications to **Schedule XCIV – Mali** was communicated to all Members of the World Trade Organization in document G/MA/TAR/RS/498 on 26 July 2017, and no objections to the proposed modifications and rectifications were received within three months from the date of issue of the aforementioned document;
