CERTIFICATION OF MODIFICATIONS AND RECTIFICATIONS

SCHEDULE XCIII - SLOVAK REPUBLIC

WHEREAS the CONTRACTING PARTIES to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1947 adopted, on 26 March 1980, a Decision on Procedures for Modification and Rectification of Schedules of Tariff Concessions (BISD 27S/25);

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Decision, a draft containing modifications and rectifications to Schedule XCIII – Slovak Republic was communicated to all Members of the World Trade Organization in document G/MA/TAR/RS/70 on 13 October 2000;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the following modifications and rectifications to Schedule XCIII – Slovak Republic are established in conformity with the above-mentioned Decision:

Insert in chapter "Pharmaceuticals" a new second paragraph into "Explanation of notes and symbols used in this Schedule", as follows -

"The concessions on additional pharmaceutical products, as defined in document G/MA/W/18 containing the revised consolidated version of Annexes 1-4, to eliminate tariffs shall be implemented in five equal annual stages beginning on 1 January 2000 and ending on 1 January 2004."

These modifications and rectifications are effective as of 13 January 2001.

This Certification is deposited with the Director-General of the World Trade Organization, who shall promptly furnish a certified true copy to each Member of the World Trade Organization. It shall be registered in accordance with the provisions of Article 102 of the Charter of the United Nations.
