SCHEDULE LXII - ICELAND

WHEREAS the CONTRACTING PARTIES to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1947 adopted, on 8 October 1991, a Decision on Procedures to Implement Changes in the Harmonized System (L/6905);

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Decision, drafts containing modifications and rectifications to Schedule LXII - Iceland were communicated to all Members of the World Trade Organization in documents G/SECRET/HS96/38 of 10 June 1997, G/SECRET/HS96/38/Corr.1 of 26 November 1997, G/SECRET/HS96/38/Add.1 of 29 January 1999 and G/SECRET/HS96/38/Add.2 of 28 October 2002;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the modifications and rectifications to Schedule LXII – Iceland are established in conformity with the above-mentioned Decision.

The annexed Schedule is effective as of 27 January 2003.
