SCHEDULE XV – PAKISTAN

WHEREAS the CONTRACTING PARTIES to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1947 adopted, on 26 March 1980, a Decision on Procedures for Modification and Rectification of Schedules of Tariff Concessions (BISD 27S/25);

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Decision, a draft containing modifications and rectifications to Schedule XV – Pakistan was communicated to all Members of the World Trade Organization in document G/MA/TAR/RS/94 on 14 July 2003, G/MA/TAR/RS/94/Add.1 on 29 June 2004 and G/MA/TAR/RS/94/Add.2 on 26 July 2005.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the modifications and rectifications to Schedule XV – Pakistan are established in conformity with the above-mentioned Decision.

The annexed modifications and rectifications are effective as of **26 October 2005**.
